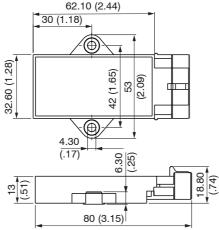
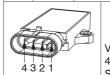


Abb. 1 Dimensional drawing, dimensions in mm (inches), not to scale
